TEXT OF AIBEA'S CIRCULAR ON

- **Clarion call from AIBEA Central Committeemeeting**
- **CC calls for intensified preparations for the strugglesahead**
- **Trade Union Convention gives the call for indefinite strike by entire working class against anti-worker policies of CentralGovernment**
- **Implement UFBU's call for strike on 22nd August,2017**
- **Mobilise massively for Morcha to Parliament on 15th September,2017**

Central Committee meeting of AIBEA was held at Delhi on 8th and 9th August, 2017. In the absence of our President Com Rajen Nagar, who could not attend due to unavoidable domestic reasons, the meeting was presided over by Com J P Sharma, Com M MRai and Com MdNazirQureshi, our Vice Presidents. From AIBOA, our meeting was attended by Com. S Nagarajan, General Secretary and Com AlokKhare, Vice Chairman.

Homage: The meeting paid homage to departed leaders Com G S Rajput, former General Secretary, EMBEA, Com. P K Lahkar, former General Secretary, Assam Provincial Bank Employees Association, Com. WallamSohtun, President of Meghalaya Bank Employees Association, Com AshwiniVij, Joint Secretary of All India Bank Deposit Collectors Federation, and Com D Gnaniah, former leader of Post and Telecom employees.

Inspiring call from National Trade Union Convention: The CC welcomed the declaration of the National Trade Union Convention held on 8th morning at Talkatora stadium to fight back the anti-worker labour policies of the BJP led NDA Government at the Centre. Entire Central Committee of the AIBEA participated in the Convention and had the benefit of the deliberation of the Convention. The Convention has given the following programmes:

1. To work for achieving and accelerating united struggles in all the sectors of the economy on respective demands, which has already begun
2. To Organize Block/District/Industrial Centres/State level massive campaign, mobilisation and convention in preparation to central mobilization to be followed
3. Massive **three days dharna** at National Capital on **9th, 10th and 11th Nov.** to be attended by lakhs of workers from all over the country.
4. The National Convention calls upon the working people to prepare for **indefinite country wide strike action** against the anti-people, anti-national activities of the Govt.

All India Bank Strike on 22nd August, 2017: The CC called upon all our unions and members to make the ensuing strike action on 22nd August, 2017 a total success in all the Banks and in all the States under the banner of UFBU.

Morcha to Parliament on 15th September: The CC noted that all our State Federations and unions are taking steps to mobilise our members for the Parliament Morcha programme on 15th September, 2017. The CC noted that this programme will now be carried out under the banner of UFBU.

Wage Revision: The CC took note of the developments on the ongoing negotiations with the IBA regarding our Charter of Demands for the 11th Bipartite Wage Settlement.

Organisation: The CC underscored the need for strengthening our organisation at all levels in the face of increasing attacks on our jobs, job security, trade union rights, public sector banking, etc. and emphasised that the need of the hour is more and more unity and further preparedness for intensified struggles.

The CC appreciated the arrangements made by Delhi Federation for hosting this important CC meeting successfully.

Comrades, we are passing through a tough time and only a strong organisation can face these challenges. Let us move accordingly.
